

Graduation Requirement (Matriculation Year 2025)

Must complete all the below requirements

1. Enroll more than 6 semesters, not more than 16 semesters
2. Should earn more than 130 credits in total
3. Earn a CGPA of 2.0 or above in total, with the CGPA for major courses being over 2.0
4. Liberal Education(교양): at least 36 credits

- Subjects offered by other departments regarded as an Elective Major (타 학과(부) 전공 선택 인정 교과목), major courses from multi majoring departments, and transferred exchange credits regarded as Electives are accepted

7. English Proficiency

- Must submit not-expired (expiration date is after the start of the graduation semester: March 1 for Spring semester, September 1 for Fall semester) English test scores during the graduation semester
- Should submit scores for all three tests below:
